DEAR EXHIBITORS AT THE JETPOWER EVENT 2019,

as described in the Fair Regulations, all exhibitors who have model jets in their range will be assigned one company slot each day to demonstrate their models. We need additional information on the models for our procedural planning for the **JetPower Event**.

If you are an exhibitor, but have no models in your range, you do not need to provide further information.

All other exhibitors need to provide the following information; the appropriate form can be found in the media library:

- Do you have models in your range which you wish to display to the public in a company slot?
- How many models do you wish to display in the flight slot?
- Types of model - jet trainer, scale, sport jet, turboprop, turbine helicopter, EDF model, etc.
- All-up weight of the model
- Do you or do you not have an approval certificate for any models above 25 kg AUW?
- Pilot's insurance (insurance company)

PROCEDURE AND ALLOCATION

Each exhibitor who manufactures or distributes models is assigned one company slot per day. The duration of the company slot will vary according to the size of the exhibitor's stand, and the number of exhibitors. Multiple models may be flown simultaneously. The exhibitor will be informed of the allocation and order of the company slot in good time before the Fair.

The information on the form is also available to our commentators, who will use the data as part of their presentation. Please note that it is **essential** to state the turbine, servos, power supply system and lighting installed in the models. The exhibitors of these items are not assigned company slots, but it is clearly important that they are mentioned during the displays! We recommend that you complete the form in German and English, as the JetPower Event is widely acknowledged to be international in character - and that applies to the exhibitors, too. With your help we can present all information in bilingual form.

In addition to the company slots we also intend to incorporate a **Show Block twice each day**, each of which will last for 30 minutes: one Show Block at 12.30, and the second at 15.30. We will directly select and invite the pilots and models for the Show Blocks. Please note that a maximum of six individual displays will be possible per Show Block.

No models will fly in the Show Blocks which are already registered in the Company slots.

Before each flight every model will be subjected to a technical examination: a brief check of the internal arrangement, wiring, control surface linkages, etc. Inspections are to be carried out on our account by two experienced examiners: **Walter Spannagel** and **Christian Lohwasser**. Models will not be permitted to fly until they have passed this check.

All pilots must have proof of adequate insurance. All foreign pilots who have no insurance valid for Germany can obtain this insurance from the **DMFV** in the exhibitor area itself; cover lasts for the duration of the JetPower Event.

All models **over 25 kg** must have a German approval certificate if they are to be permitted to fly at the JetPower Event. **This is a requirement of the German Luftamt (aviation authority). It is a safety measure, and there is no way of circumventing it for the JetPower Event. This is the fundamental rule: no model over 25 kg will be permitted to fly without a valid approval certificate!**

For this reason we have hired a hangar from the airfield operator, adjacent to the JetPower Fair marquee, in which it is possible to obtain an approval certificate for the model on site. Approval will be granted by **DMFV examiners (DMFV: Deutscher Modellflieger Verband - German Model Flying Association)**.

Our examiners will have access to all equipment required for the approval procedure. The staff will be available to you on site as of Wednesday, 11.09.2019.

If you are an exhibitor who wishes to take part in the Flight Show with a model whose all-up weight is more than 25 kg, we urge you to make contact with Florian Keilwitz **at the latest two weeks before the Fair**. He will clarify the technical equipment required in the model, explain the procedure and also provide information on the cost. **A pilot's examination is also required (theoretical and practical check).**

Acceptance flights will be possible on Wednesday, 11.09.2019 and Thursday, 12.09.2019, and also on Friday, Saturday and Sunday, in each case in the period between 9.00 am and 10.00 am. Acceptance flights will **not** be possible during the Flight Display!

Special weighing apparatus will be present at the flightline. This apparatus will be used to check that all models are within the 25 kg limit.

A Pilot Briefing will be held on the airfield at 9.00 am on Friday, Saturday and Sunday. **All pilots must attend the briefings!**
